Through his 10 years of experience, he has managed the data collection on over 400,000 trees and has assessed each for a variety of biotic and abiotic factors. TJ possesses an ISA Tree Risk Assessment Qualification and assists cities in prioritizing maintenance by applying risk assessment factors to each tree inventoried. Also, TJ provides software training and facilitates workshops around the country to broaden knowledge on tree inventories and the technology used to collect important attributes.

Ian is Principal and co-founding member of True Tree Service. Ian has overseen daily operations of prescribed tree management (structural pruning, invasive tree removal, cabling and bracing, etc.), horticulture management and arboriculture consultation.
